Watpac secures Mayfair Hotel contract and commences work

Watpac Limited today announced it had finalised contractual negotiations with Adabco Properties Pty Ltd for the \$32 million redevelopment of Adelaide's historic Colonial Mutual Life (CML) building into a 4.5 star boutique hotel.

Early works on the building – to be called the Mayfair Hotel – have commenced with construction scheduled for completion in December 2013.
