Grant of Incentive Rights – Appendix 3B and Appendix 3Y

Following approval at the 2012 Annual General Meeting of WPG Resources Ltd (WPG or the Company) held today, the Company has granted 1,044,759 incentive rights to Executive Directors. The proposed grant of these rights was first advised on 3 August 2012, as part of a grant of 4,598,165 Incentive Rights, to senior executives and Executive Directors.

Attached are completed Appendix 3B and Appendix 3Y Notices with respect to the incentive rights issues.

Additional information is also included in the attached Appendix 3B pursuant to the approval of a resolution to issue equity securities equivalent to an additional 10% of the number of ordinary securities on issue by way of placements over a 12 month period under Listing Rule 7.1A passed by special resolution today. The Board has no current intention to undertake a placement of shares, rather, the approval of the resolution provides the Board with the maximum flexibility with regard to future capital raising or asset acquisitions.
