John Holland Awarded \$148 Million Moorebank Units Relocation Sub-Contract

Sydney, 6 March, 2013: John Holland has been awarded a \$148 million sub-contract as part of the \$870 million dollar Moorebank Units Relocation (MUR) at Holsworthy Army Barracks.

John Holland has been sub-contracted by Managing Contractor, Laing O'Rourke, as part of work to be completed for the Defence Department. John Holland will provide preparatory works for the MUR project, including bulk earth-works, construction of building pads, and installation of in-ground services infrastructure as well as construction works for roads, pavements and retaining walls.

John Holland Group Managing Director, Glenn Palin, said the project continues the company's proud tradition of working on Defence projects.
