

ALAN JONES SIGNS NEW CONTRACT WITH MACQUARIE RADIO

JONES COMMITS TO FURTHER 2 YEARS HOSTING 2GB BREAKFAST SHOW

Macquarie Radio Network ("MRN"), owner of Sydney radio station's 2GB and 2CH, today announced that Alan Jones has re-signed with the network for a further 2 years, to June 2015.

Jones has hosted 2GB's Breakfast Show since 2002. His program has been Sydney's highest rating breakfast radio show for the last 10 years, recording in that period an astounding 82 consecutive ratings wins.

In announcing the new contract, MRN Executive Chairman, Russell Tate, said that MRN's Board and shareholders were delighted that Jones had decided to continue broadcasting for another 2 years at least. "Alan is without doubt the most successful and influential broadcaster in the country", Tate said. "He is sounding better now than ever, he is fit and is still working as hard as he ever has. Alan has committed to maintaining his current broadcast hours for another 2 years definitely and this contract gives us the right, if he chooses to continue beyond June 2015, to ensure he does so with 2GB".
