



## RESMED INC. ANNOUNCES EXCHANGE RATE FOR UPCOMING DIVIDEND PAYMENT

SAN DIEGO, May 23, 2013 – ResMed Inc. (NYSE: RMD) announced today that the dividend to be paid on June 18, 2013, to holders of Chess Depositary Instruments (CDIs) trading on the Australian Securities Exchange will be Australian dollar \$0.01734 per CDI.

ResMed previously declared a quarterly dividend of US dollar \$0.17 per share, which had a record date of May 21, 2013, and will be payable on June 18, 2013. The dividend will be paid in US currency to holders of its common stock trading on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE).

The dividend paid in Australian currency to CDI holders reflects the exchange rate on the record date, which was US dollars \$0.9803 for each Australian dollar \$1.00, and reflects the 10:1 ratio between CDIs and US common shares listed on the NYSE.
